Out of which 1 unit is selected for the Special Camp. From this Seven Day Special Camp, Volunteers supposed to know the village level problems and responsibilities in society so that he develop his personality and through this camp, lectures and various programs, he will develop his own, society's confidence and he will try to develop through this special camp.

So NSS of college carried out a Seven Day Special Camp from 15th March 2022 to 21st March 2022 at adopted village Talandage. The report of the programs carried out at the camp are as below :-

- Tuesday, 15th March 2022 There was a inauguration ceremary of this camp on the first day of college by Prin. Dr. H.S. Vanamare (Former Coordinator, Department of NSS, Shivaji University, Kolhapur). Then volunteers cleaned the area where they are going to live for next seven days.
